

### EXTRA Fund

The Beaconsfield School run a school EXTRA donation facility to raise funds for the development of the Schools facilities and the lives of our students within school.

The EXTRA fund runs every academic year to raise income for projects of immediate need around the school. The projects funded will enhance and broaden the life and educational experience of the students of The Beaconsfield School.

If all parents in Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4 were to donate just £2.50 per month to the school, the price of two bottles of water, it would raise an amazing £22,500 in one year! That is equivalent to a new minibus.

**How to make a donation using Gift Aid:**

In order to make a Gift Aid donation you will need to fill in a Gift Aid Declaration. By completing this, The Beaconsfield School can cover every gift made to the school for whatever period you choose, and can cover gifts you have already made and/or gifts you make in the future.

A Gift Aid Declaration must include the following information:

- \*Your full name
- \*Your home address
- \*Details of your donation
- \*Amount
- \*Frequency of donation
- \*Commencement date
- \*Termination date
- \*Your Bank/Building Society details

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment Tax Return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.

Please notify the school if you:

- \*Wish to cancel the declaration
- \*Change your name or home address
- \*No longer pay sufficient tax on your income/capital gains

The Gift Aid scheme is for gifts of money by individuals who pay UK tax. Gift Aid donations are regarded as having basic rate tax deducted by the donor. Charities take your donation – which is the money you have already paid tax on – and reclaim the basic rate tax from HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) on its “gross” equivalent – the amount before basic rate tax was deducted.
