Dear Parents/Carers

KS3 Enrichment Day – Monday 6th July 2020

We are in the process of organising our next Enrichment Day being held on Monday 6th July 2020.

We have tried to provide a diverse range of activities covering all interests, available to all age groups. These proposals will, I hope, allow all students to interact across all year groups in as many activities as possible. The activities also provide great value for money with all activity leaders working hard to provide quality, fun filled experiences at the best possible price. As a result, students will be able to experience new things, meet new friends and devote time to activities they will enjoy. Excitingly, students may even have the chance to experience something for the first time that may inspire them.

Please read through the selection of experiences carefully and decide on **three** activities that you would like your child to take part in. On the booking form provided at the end of this letter please complete the choices section with your **top three selections**. We will do all we can to ensure you get your first choice activity, but, numbers on some trips are limited and we cannot always guarantee you will get your first choice place. If you return a form with only 1 choice marked you will be given lower priority than students who complete the process accurately. If you have any questions about the trips or activities provided before or after making your choice, please contact me.

Students need to return their completed choices reply slip back to the post box outside the Finance Office by the end of mentor time on **Friday, 18th October 2019**, at the latest.

Should a trip be oversubscribed, names will be drawn at random after the deadline. Students that fail to return their form will remain in school and undertake lessons on 6th July.

Once allocations are published, all students will be given a week in which they will have the opportunity to check which trip they are on. If there are any unforeseen problems that may affect them taking part in their assigned trip, this will be the time to make any changes that may be necessary – please contact me on lmartin@beaconsfield.school.

Following this one week period, if we have not heard anything back from you, then we will assume that you have made a commitment to pay for your child's assigned activities in July 2020 and we will pay holding deposits on your behalf. Please note that no cancellation refunds will be given if a student decides to withdraw after this time. Additionally, participation will be based on acceptable behaviour at school throughout the year, we will be unable to refund any payments made to external agencies on your behalf, should your son/daughter lose their place due to behavioural concerns.

Payment details for each activity will be confirmed once students have been assigned a place on a particular activity (other than the Battlefields Trip for which deposits must have already been paid).

The school's method of payment is through ParentPay. If you have any problems making payment, please contact Lorraine Brown on 01494 683993. ParentPay holds an electronic record of your payments to view at a later date; however, no card details are stored in any part of the system. **If your child is eligible for a free school meal, no payment will be necessary but the reply slip with your choices must still be returned by the deadline.**

Please contact us if you have any questions or requests regarding payments and we will do our very best to help and advise you.

We hope that the range of activities offered contains something for everyone and we as a school are very much looking forward to taking part in this Enrichment Day.

Battlefields Trip	Please see email sent earlier in the term. London	This day trip will involve a whirl around the London Eye, a river cruise on the Thames and a visit to the London Sea Life Centre. Transport by coach.	Slightly extended school day.	£37.50	100
Bletchley Park	Bletchley Park, once the top-secret home of the WW2 Codebreakers is now a vibrant heritage attraction. This visit includes an interactive one hour workshop session in which students will use practical problem solving and team working skills as they begin to understand the scale of the task faced by Bletchley Park's codebreakers during World War Two. This will be followed by a 50 minute guided tour around the outside of the buildings, providing opportunity for students to delve deeper into the story of Bletchley Park and the process of sending, intercepting and decrypting coded messages. There will also be self guided time which allows groups to explore the mansion, museums, huts (and of course the shop) at their own pace. Transport by coach.	Normal School Day	£23.95	50
Cotswold Wildlife Park.	At the Cotswold Wildlife Park, they have created enclosures that are spacious and carefully landscaped, with no intrusive fencing, taking full advantage of the beautiful rural setting of the Bradwell Grove Estate. This means that visitors can get 'closer to wildlife' giving the Park the feel of a 'walking safari'. See the wide array of animals and enjoy the beautiful grounds. Transport by coach.
