- ·Record ideas on tape
- ·Say keywords aloud
- ·Tell another person
- ·Make a presentation
- ·Get someone to test you.
- ·Exchange ideas with your friends
- ·Play quiet, relaxing background music.

Kinesthetic Learners:

- Walk n' talk,
- Draw cartoons,
- Posters etc.,
- Make a model,
- Role play/ Drama,
- Make a Mind Map,
- Write a story,
- Annotate diagrams,
- Make Cue/Flash cards or bookmarks.
