Visual Learners:

- Maps
- Posters
- Charts
- Spider diagrams
- Cartoons
- Summary notes
- Mental Pictures
- Mind maps

Auditory Learners:

- Record ideas on tape
- Say keywords aloud
- Tell another person
- Make a presentation
- Get someone to test you.
- Exchange ideas with your friends
- Play quiet, relaxing background music.

Kinesthetic Learners:

Walk n' talk,

Draw cartoons,

Posters etc.,

Make a model,

Role play/ Drama,

Make a Mind Map,

Write a story,

Annotate diagrams,

Make Cue/Flash cards or bookmarks.
