Dear Parents/Carers

**Re: Year 13**

I hope that you and your family are well. I am writing to confirm the arrangements for Results Day on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August 2020.

All results will be emailed to students, **using their school email addresses, at 8am**. Those who are waiting for confirmation of University places should also receive information from UCAS, from 8am (this was earlier in previous years). This is the first year that we have emailed out results in this way, but this will enable those who need to contact Universities about their University places, to have the full details about their grades, and to be able to speak to UCAS and individual Universities as quickly as possible.

We will also be in school to hand out results, **from 8.30am until 10am** (a change from 9am in the exam booklet), and this will take place **in the Hub**. Students will need to collect their results and then go to the garden area (behind the Hub) – where there will be room for social distancing. If the weather is inclement then it will be possible to move into the Hall, after collecting results. For those who do not want to collect the results in person, the results will be posted to the student's home address. Alternatively, if they wish to nominate someone else (including a parent) to collect the results, written authorisation must be emailed to the [exams@beaconsfield.school](mailto:exams@beaconsfield.school)

For anyone who wants advice about changing University courses, deferring for a year or applying through clearing, **Mr Fletcher and I will be available throughout the morning of the 13<sup>th</sup>**. We have set up a booking system using the Parents Evening Booking System, which will allow an appointment to be made from 10am, once the results have been received. Alternatively, from 8.30am to 10am we will both be available to give advice, without a booking.

Universities have indicated that they may limit the number of students who can defer their place, so it is advisable that your son or daughter contacts the Universities, if they are considering deferment. It may be that students will have to re-apply for 2021 if they do not want to take up their place in the Autumn, in which case, we will of course provide assistance and a reference.

There are still many uncertainties about the process of taking exams next year, if students are disappointed with their calculated grades, but we do know that **resit A Level exams will take place at some point during the Autumn term**. We will hopefully have more details soon.

The Leavers Hoodies will be available to pick up on Results Day, but an alternative date to pick them up, can be arranged, if you contact me on [jodonnell@beaconsfield.school](mailto:jodonnell@beaconsfield.school).
