Biometric Cashless Catering

The Beaconsfield School operates a cashless catering system in The Hub. The biometric identification system uses the finger and its image to uniquely identify each student. The system measures many aspects of the finger and then translates the information into a unique identification code which is kept on the school's system. The image of the fingerprint itself is not recorded or stored and cannot be regenerated from the digital data.

We would like to make it clear that The Beaconsfield School will comply at all times with the Data Protection Act and with the provisions of the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012 (which came into force in September 2013) regarding the use of biometric data.

In order for your child to use the biometric system, one parent or carer will need to provide consent by signing and returning the attached form. Those who opted not to use the Biometric system, will automatically be issued with a four digit pin number which they will then enter at the till point.
