Disadvantaged Students at The Beaconsfield School Sixth Form Policy 2018-2019

All students who have been identified as disadvantaged at Key Stage 3 and 4 are eligible to apply for additional funding, through The Bursary System.

This Bursary system is means tested, dependent on household income and there are three levels of financial assistance available.

If the criteria for the bursary are met, then students are able to use their funds to buy clothes to meet the Sixth Form dress code and suitable for University and Apprenticeship interviews.

The bursary can also be used to buy books, devices, stationery and to meet transport costs to and from school and to fund school trips and visit to universities.

Students who receive bursary funding and those who have previously been identified as disadvantaged, are monitored closely by the Sixth Form team, to ensure that they are able to attain their full potential. Recent students have gone on to study International Business Management, Graphic Design, Film Production and an Art Foundation Course. Current Bursary students are applying to study a wide range of subjects including Sport Science, Anthropology and Biomedical Science, and some intend to apply for degree level apprenticeships.
