RUBY POWER – SUPPORTING OTHERS

You give support to others by listening to them and smiling at them

You praise others when they do well

You help others when they have a problem

You develop trust in teams and it gives you the ability to take risks in your learning



EMERALD POWER – BEING COURAGEOUS AND STICKING WITH IT

You are brave and comfortable enough to 'have a go' with your learning even though you know you might make a mistake

You learn from your mistakes and 'bounce back', you stick with it

You remain calm even though you have been upset or angry



DIAMOND POWER – BEING RESPONSIBLE AND ABLE TO IDENTIFY PROBLEMS

You try to solve problems yourself rather than relying on an adult

You use different strategies to identify what you need to do when you are stuck you don't always just go straight to your teacher.



SAPPHIRE POWER – KEEPING FOCUS

You can keep focus and on task even when there are lots of distractions

You keep listening to others (teacher and others in the class) even when there are distractions

You can fight off the monster distraction
